Doctoral, Master and Postgraduate Diploma Programs Academic Year 2019/2020

Sultan Qaboos University announces its postgraduate programs for Omani and non-Omani students. Programs start in September 2019

General Admission Requirements for PhD Programs:

1. Applicant must be a master's degree holder, from Sultan Qaboos University, or any other recognized institution in a field related to the program applied for, and must be a Bachelor degree from a recognized university.
2. A Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of not less than 3.00 on a 4.00 point scale or equivalent. The Dean of Postgraduate Studies will make the assessment for equivalency acceptance.
3. Applicants with a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) between 2.75 and 2.99 on a 4.0 point scale may be considered for admission subject with a minimum of two years of work experience and any other relevant academic activity.
4. Applicant must submit a proposal that explains the student's research topic and includes the research problem, objectives, questions and method of data collection.
5. Two recommendation letters from academic staff in the applicant's competence in the discipline of interest and also to their research capability.
6. Applicant must submit a release letter or a study leave from employer for full-time study or no-objection letter for part-time study, addressed to the Dean of Postgraduate Studies at SQU. Unemployed applicants need to submit a statement from The Public Authority of Manpower Register documenting the unemployment status of the applicant.
7. Applicants must submit an English Proficiency Test Certificate with the level required for the program applied for, provided that the expiry date is less than two years from the date of the application submission period.

General Admission Requirements for Masters Programs:

1. Applicant must be an undergraduate degree holder from Sultan Qaboos University, or any other recognized institution in a field related to the program applied for.
2. A Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of not less than 2.75 on a 4.00 point scale or equivalent. The Dean of Postgraduate Studies will make the assessment for equivalency acceptance.
3. Applicants with a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) between 2.5 and 2.74 on a 4.0 point scale or its equivalent with a minimum of two years of work experience or any other academic activity following graduation.
4. Applicant must submit an English Proficiency Test Certificate with the level required for the program applied for, provided that the test date is less than two years from the date of the announcement.
5. Applicant must submit a release letter or a study leave from employer for full-time study or no-objection letter for part-time study, addressed to the Dean of Postgraduate Studies at SQU. Unemployed applicants need to submit a statement from The Public Authority of Manpower Register documenting the unemployment status of the applicant.

General Admission Requirements for Postgraduate Diploma programs:

1. Applicant must be an undergraduate degree holder from Sultan Qaboos University, or any other recognized institution in a field related to the program applied for.
2. Applicant for postgraduate diploma in translation must have a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of not less than 2.5 on a 4.00 point scale or equivalent. The Dean of Postgraduate Studies will make the assessment for equivalency acceptance.
3. English Certificate of not less than 5.0 in IELTS or 60 in TOEFL through the internet.
4. Applicant must submit a release letter or a study leave from employer for full-time study or no-objection letter for part-time study, addressed to the Dean of Postgraduate Studies at SQU. Unemployed applicants need to submit a statement from The Public Authority of Manpower Register documenting the unemployment status of the applicant.

Academic Fees:

The University charges tuition fees for enrollment in postgraduate programs and all applicants for these programs are considered at their own expense in accordance with the tuition fees shown on the University's website.

Postgraduate Scholarships & Sponsorships:

Candidates in postgraduate programs can also compete for the following scholarships:

1. University scholarships:
 - Number of scholarships for master and doctorate - for Omani and Non-Omani students.
 - Scholarships for Ministry of Education (25 exemption from Tuition Fees for Master - Omani).
 - Scholarships for Ministry of Endowments and Religious Affairs (two full scholarships for Master - Non-Omani).
 - Scholarships for Palestinian Students (two full time for Master).
2. Sponsored Scholarships:
 - PhD Scholarships (3 full Scholarships for Master - Omani).
 - CGO Unifair for Services Sponsorships (one exemption from tuition fees for Master - Omani).
 - Oman Oil Marketing Company (3 exemption from tuition fees for Master - Omani).

2. Application Period: 1/1/2019 to 28/2/2019

3. Documents needed: Applicants must upload the following documents electronically (use the online application system (PDF and jpg only):

Notes:

1. The Academic regulations for postgraduate studies 2011 1st Edition will be applied and applicants must meet the following requirements. For more information please visit the website.
2. Applicant who meets the admission requirements may be invited for assessment as per program requirements.
3. Certificate and Transcripts submitted must be authenticated.
4. Accepted candidate needs to have their academic documents attested and qualifications equivalence by Ministry of Higher Education in Oman through their website www.mhe.gov.om before starting their study in the first semester. If the procedures of the approval take time by the Ministry may be considered to register in the first semester and should be followed before they start of registration for the second semester otherwise the acceptance and registration of the applicant will be cancelled.
5. Applications, which do not meet admission requirements or authentication, will not be considered.
6. Accepted candidate can be given unconditional offer if all requirements are fulfilled before 28/2/2019.
7. Unconditional letter requirements will subsequently be fulfilled before 30/9/2019, the university reserve the right to consider or not consider the possibility of transferring his/her acceptance to the second semester of the academic year 2019/2020.
8. Applicants who are in the last semester of study may be considered subject to evidence of the expected graduation date before the start of the study. Failure to achieve the required CGPA at the time of graduation, however, will result in revocation of admission.
9. Accepted candidate with English level 5.5 in IELTS or 60 in TOEFL can join an English course during the first semester before registering for a Master program and should pass it.
10. Accepted candidate with English level 6.0 in IELTS or 70 in TOEFL, can join an English course during the first semester before registering for a PhD program and should pass it.
11. Except of an application by the Dean of Postgraduate Studies does not commit the University to accept the candidate.
12. The University reserves the right to withdraw the application if there are insufficient number of applicants.
13. The University reserves the right to withdraw the application if the applicant fails to meet any of the requirements within the specified period in the admission notification and also the submission is considered not acceptable if it is found in any way that the applicant does not meet the specified conditions of reasons, test results and interviews.
14. Applicants are not allowed to apply for a program from which they have been dismissed, unless the date of dismissal was more than two years before the application.
15. Applicants can apply for more than one program through creating an account for each program applied for consideration may be given in a situation in which the assessment date is in parallel with the other applied programs (Except the College of Law).
16. Candidates admitted conditionally into the Master program by taking Bridging course must fulfill the Master program admission requirements as specified in the program descriptions before starting the Bridging course.
17. Student admitted in the program and who fulfills the scholarship requirements is not automatically granted a scholarship. Scholarships are awarded according to availability of funds and merit of the student.
18. Applicants and admitted students in the various programs will be subject to all regulations and decisions that will be issued before the beginning of the academic year 2019/2020.
